This is one of five works of art commissioned for the new Petroleum Club through Kinzelman Art Consulting and has a place of honor in the Club's bar. The German-born, Dallas-based artist, Reinhard Ziegler, bridges the boundaries between photography and painting. His works are meant to trigger a sense of recognition, of having actually been there.

This one, entitled *Another Way to Measure Time*, is a photograph from West Texas captured from a moving vehicle at a slow shutter speed. The camera was held as still as possible, and the sense of motion comes from the scene being gently "smeared" across the film. A print was made on matte surface paper and then was hand-colored by working pastels directly into the surface.
